This fall, a committee of 11 members spent several months planning and producing the Fall Show. Thirty-six artists entered 204 pieces of art. There was a wide array of art mediums and styles. Sixteen pieces of art were sold. Over 500 guests visited the show and more than 40 ASSC members volunteered their time to help. The profit to the Society was nearly \$800. This was the first attempt at online registration and it went fairly smoothly. Colin McLean was our guest speaker, at Friday's Opening Night, and he certainly did his homework on the history of the ASSC and art, in general, within the County. We had a People's Choice Award and the painting chosen was by Allan Milne. There was a lovely spread of food and beverages on Friday evening, and snacks were served all weekend during the show. Harpist, David Humphreys, provided background music for the evening. Many people complimented the ASSC and the Fall Show committee on a great show. I would like to thank the committee members, Sue Borland, Norma Callicott, Leslie Degner, Fiona

getting to know our ASSC members! the artwork of Allan Milne



Introducing, long time resident of Sherwood Park and member of the ASSC, Allan Milne. He has a passion for art that shows up in his own unique, but bold, contemporary paintings. Allan has always been interested in visual art, but more than that, the creative process. For this reason he ended up taking art in high school and further on to the University of Alberta where he completed the Bachelor of Education program. He has taught for 14 years, 10 of those years in the art classroom, with the majority being at the high school. Allan continues to share his passion for art at the Art Society of Strathcona County. "As an artist, I have grown a lot over the past eight years with some changes to my style, but overall sticking to a bolder statement with colour and composition. I do like looking at pieces that I created when I first started and see how I have grown technically as an artist. The past couple of years have seen considerable growth in my art through the different venues, festivals, and shows that I participate in. I participate regularly in the Art Society annual spring and fall shows, the Whyte Avenue Artwalk, and an Indie arts and crafts show called "Make It". Lately, I have been focusing on commissions coming from as far away as Palm Springs, for a soapstone sculpture and Ottawa for a painting."

As of late, Allan's work was chosen for the Strathcona County Art Acquisition and he placed second at the last juried Art Society show. As well, he has won the People's Choice Award in the past two Art Society shows! Outside the world of art, Allan's passion is his wonderful wife and three incredible children!
